

Debbie DeCoito was present at the Trinity County Board of Supervisors' meeting on November 7th as Jesse Cox, NoRTEC Workforce Development Board Member, was recognized for his 19 years of service on the Trinity County Fire Safe Council. Supervisor John Fenley, Chair of the Trinity BOS and the NoRTEC Governing Board, presented the Proclamation to Jesse. Under Jesse's leadership the Trinity County Fire Safe Council:

- Authored on the nation's first Community Wildfire Protection Plans (CWPP) and two updates of the CWPP
- Spearheaded the "Big Red Truck" defensible space inspection program
- Completed Firewise Community Recognition for 15 communities in Trinity County; and
- Supported implementation of dozens of fuels reduction projects throughout Trinity County, representing millions of dollars of investment and thousands of acres of work to reduce the risk of catastrophic fire.
